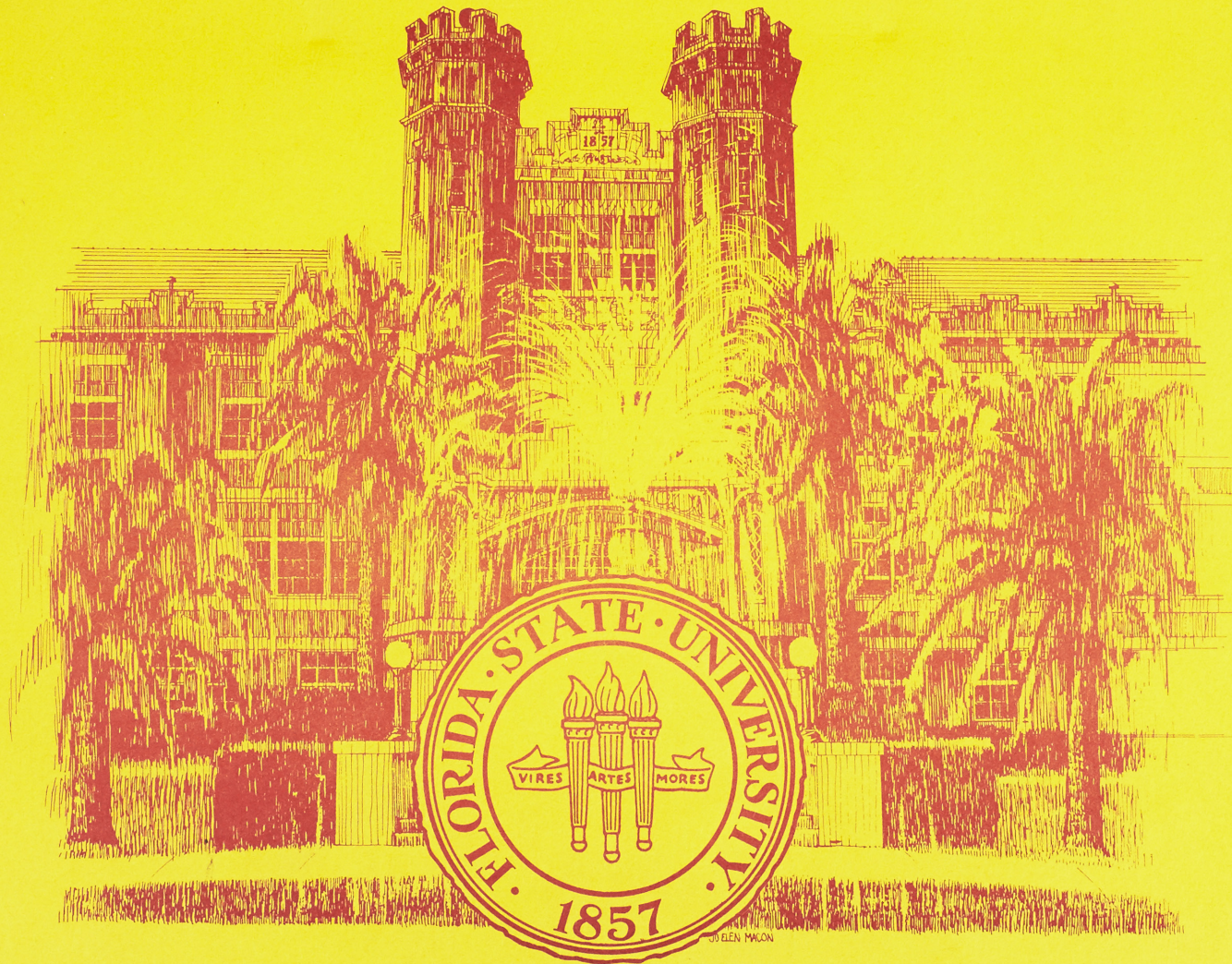

- . THE AVERAGE AGE OF UNDERGRADUATES AND GRADUATES WAS 21 AND 29, RESPECTIVELY. THE AVERAGE AGE OF ALL STUDENTS WAS 23.
- . WOMEN CONSTITUTED A SLIGHT MAJORITY—ACCOUNTING FOR 53% OF THE ENROLLEES.
- . SIXTEEN PERCENT OF THE STUDENTS WERE MINORITIES.
